

# City of Napa Transit Study

## PROJECT FACT SHEET

### Purpose

Napa County Transportation and Planning Agency (NCTPA) has initiated a study in the City of Napa to evaluate existing transit services, identify travel patterns, and assess future needs. The study will assess the local demographics profile, evaluate the performance of existing transit services, identify community mobility needs, and make recommendations for the transit network, including VINE Routes 1-6, 10 and 29.

### Public Involvement

An essential part in determining transit service needs will be public involvement, including input from stakeholders, transit operators, and the community, to help identify existing service gaps and future needs. The outreach effort will gather opinions and concerns regarding the role of transit in the community, perceptions of the service, improvement priorities, and any other transportation-related issues specific to the City of Napa.

### Intended Outcome

The input obtained from this outreach effort will be used in conjunction with the existing service evaluation to help draft a future service plan. A community workshop will be held in order to present these findings and allow the public to provide input on the recommendations. The study team will then incorporate these comments into the Draft City of Napa Service Plan and develop an accompanying implementation plan.
